

# Kansas Recurring Flood Hazard Area ID Initiative

"Turn Around, Don't Drown©" signs in recurring flood locations help prevent the dangerous scenario of vehicles entering high water. The Kansas Hazard Mitigation Team is providing these signs to your community courtesy of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Silver Jackets Program.

## FREE SIGNS

We are seeking locations throughout Kansas to place signs. Sign recipients must be prepared to:

1. Install signs near recurring flood hazard locations so that they are visible to traffic, or on portable barricades that can be placed at such locations during emergencies.
2. Follow all applicable federal, state, and local safety regulations governing road signs.
3. Complete sign installation before December 31, 2018.
4. Provide photographs of at least one installed sign to the Kansas Hazard Mitigation Team.

## Easy Application Instructions

1. Mark recurring flood hazard areas using the Recurring Flood ID Project Webmap:

2. Nominate your community using the attached sheet by identifying points of contact for the necessary information.
3. Signs will be provided to the communities for installation - Signs are 18"x24" signs constructed from composite material with UV coating (similar to typical road signs).
